OpenPictures nabs rights to Intertainment titles

COLOGNE, Germany -- Munich-based media group OpenPictures said Wednesday that it has acquired the German-language free TV rights to a slate of feature films from struggling Munich-based licensor Intertainment. The package includes Intertainment-backed films like the Ed Harris starrer "The Third Miracle" as well as such straight-to-video fare as actioner "Active Stealth" and romantic comedy "The Whole Shebang." OpenPictures said it already has sold Austrian rights to the package to Austrian pubweb ORF. Intertainment, which has been crippled by legal costs associated with its long-running suit against Franchise Pictures, was forced last week to wrap up its production deal with Arnold Kopelson's Kopelson Entertainment (HR 2/13). *(Scott Roxborough)*
